Household Waste Programs

The City of Flagstaff's HPC provides FREE year-round acceptance and handling of residential household hazardous waste (HHW) and electronic waste.

HHW are used or leftover consumer products that contain toxic, reactive, ignitable or corrosive ingredients and are typically labeled: Acid, Caution, Danger, Flammable, Poison, Toxic and Warning.



What am I required to bring?

City residents are required to bring a utility bill and a valid state issued ID.

Coconino County residents are required to bring a valid state issued ID showing a current county address.



Drop and Swap

The Drop and Swap area contains **FREE** reusable products. Stock varies daily. Drop and Swap encourages the reuse, reduction and recycling of HHW.

Waste Acceptance

Acceptable wastes:

- Automotive products
- Ballasts
- Batteries
- Cell phones
- Cleaning products & aerosols
- Electronics
- Fluorescent Lamps & CFLs
- Gardening products
- Hobby chemicals
- Industrial chemicals w/MSDS
- Paint products
- Thermometers/Thermostats
- ▶ Please Note: There are limits for the amount of each waste type that can be accepted. Waste must be in 5 gallon containers or smaller unless prior approval has been given by HPC staff. Also, if you have an item not listed, please contact us.

Unacceptable wastes:

- Ammunition
- Asbestos materials
- BBQ sized propane & other large compressed gas cylinders
- Bio-hazardous waste
- Broken fluorescent lamps
- Explosives
- Fireworks and flares
- General trash/recyclables
- Medications
- Radioactive materials
- Sharps/Medical waste
- Tires

Business Waste Program

The Small Business Waste Program (SBWP) provides qualifying businesses located within Coconino County with a local, economical and year-round facility for the acceptance of hazardous waste.

Business must qualify as a Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator (CESQG)*.

*CESQG criteria

- 1. Generates less than 220 pounds of hazardous waste in a calendar month;
- 2. Accumulates at any time or generates less than 2.2 pounds of acute hazardous waste in a calendar month;
- 3. Accumulates no more than 2,200 pounds of hazardous waste at any one time

What are the costs associated with CESQG waste disposal?

The SBWP requires an annual program registration fee of \$50.00. Waste recycling/disposal costs vary by waste type and are based on the city's cost to recycle/dispose of the specific wastes.
