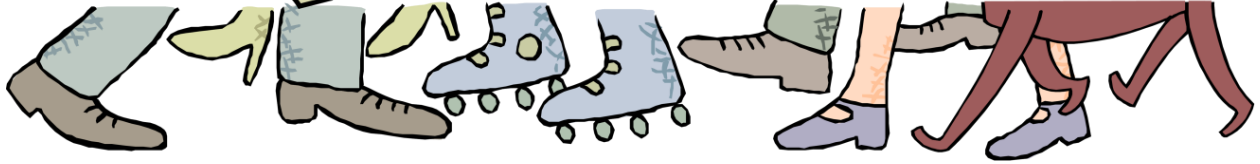


Flagstaff Walks!
