II. NEW BUSINESS

A. Lone Tree Overpass Project Update and Presentation

Flagstaff Voters passed Proposition 420 in November 2018 which funded the design and construction of the Lone Tree Overpass project. This project will connect Lone Tree Road from Butler Avenue over the future Rio de Flag channel and Burlington Northern & Santa Fe Railroad to an at-grade intersection with Route 66.

Prior to the November 2018 election the City conducted corridor studies of Lone Tree Road from John Wesley Powell to Butler and this Butler to Route 66 connection.

The Lone Tree Overpass project design effort has now been underway for several months and the design team is excited to provide a project update which includes an alternatives analysis of the potential intersection designs at Butler and Lone Tree and Route 66 and Lone Tree.

The design team will provide a detailed presentation and a draft alternative scoring matrix for review and input. The team will incorporate comments received into future discussions with the Public and the City Council.
