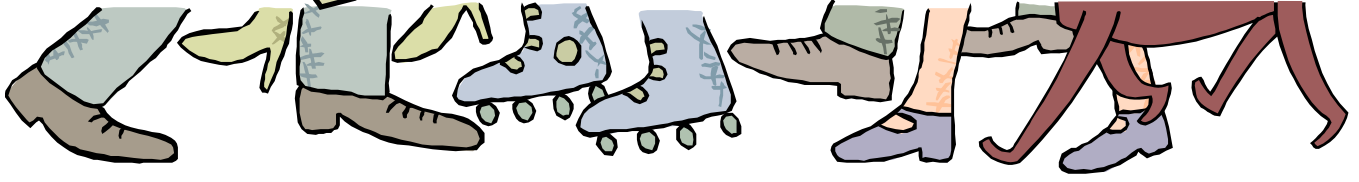


# Flagstaff Walks!
