Scavenger and Grease Waste Disposal Rates and Hours

General:

- A scavenger or grease waste permit is required for disposal of scavenger, grease, river can and car wash wastes at the Wildcat Hill Water Reclamation Plant (WRP). Permit applications are available on our website at <https://www.flagstaff.az.gov/4139/Scavenger-Waste-Disposal>, or by calling our Finance Department at (928) 213-2238.
 - Current cost for a permit is \$25/year.
 - **PLEASE NOTE** - A separate permit is required for each truck used to dispose waste at the Wildcat Hill WRP.
 - Access cards are required to utilize the septage disposal station. An access card will be issued for each truck with a current permit.
 - Lost or worn access cards are subject to a replacement fee. Lost cards may require an additional 24 hours to be reissued.
 - All waste materials and haulers must adhere to **City Code 7-02-001-0042** Septic Tank and Scavenger Waste Haulers.
- Septage and grease waste receiving station is open Monday-Friday at the following hours:
 - March 1- November 30 from 7:30 am - 2:45 pm.
 - December 1 - February 29 from 10:00 am – 2:30 pm
 - Evening, holiday and weekend loads are accepted from March 1 – November 30 based on the availability of plant personnel. All after hour loads are subject to an additional fee, as per the fee schedule in **City Code 7-02-001-0041**.
 - No evening, holiday or weekend loads are accepted from December 1 – February 29.
 - The receiving stations may be closed during inclement weather and/or mechanical issues or maintenance. Please call ahead during inclement weather for operating hours at (928) 213-2480.

Septage:

- Only septage loads that are generated within Coconino County will be accepted at the Wildcat Hill WRP.
- Current charge for septage wastes is \$8/100 gallons

Grease:

- Only grease loads that originate within a 20 mile radius of city center will be accepted at the Wildcat Hill WRP.
- Current charge for grease wastes is \$11/100 gallons.

River Cans:

- Current charge for river cans is \$1/can.

Car Wash mud sump:

- Only car wash loads that originate within the Flagstaff city limits will be accepted at the Wildcat Hill WRP.
- Current charge for car wash mud sumps is \$25/100 gallons.
- Car wash mud sump loads must be inspected by City of Flagstaff's Industrial Pretreatment Program. Please contact the Industrial Pretreatment Supervisor by calling (928) 213-2117 or (928) 607-6778, or by Email at pretreatment@flagstaffaz.gov to schedule an inspection.
