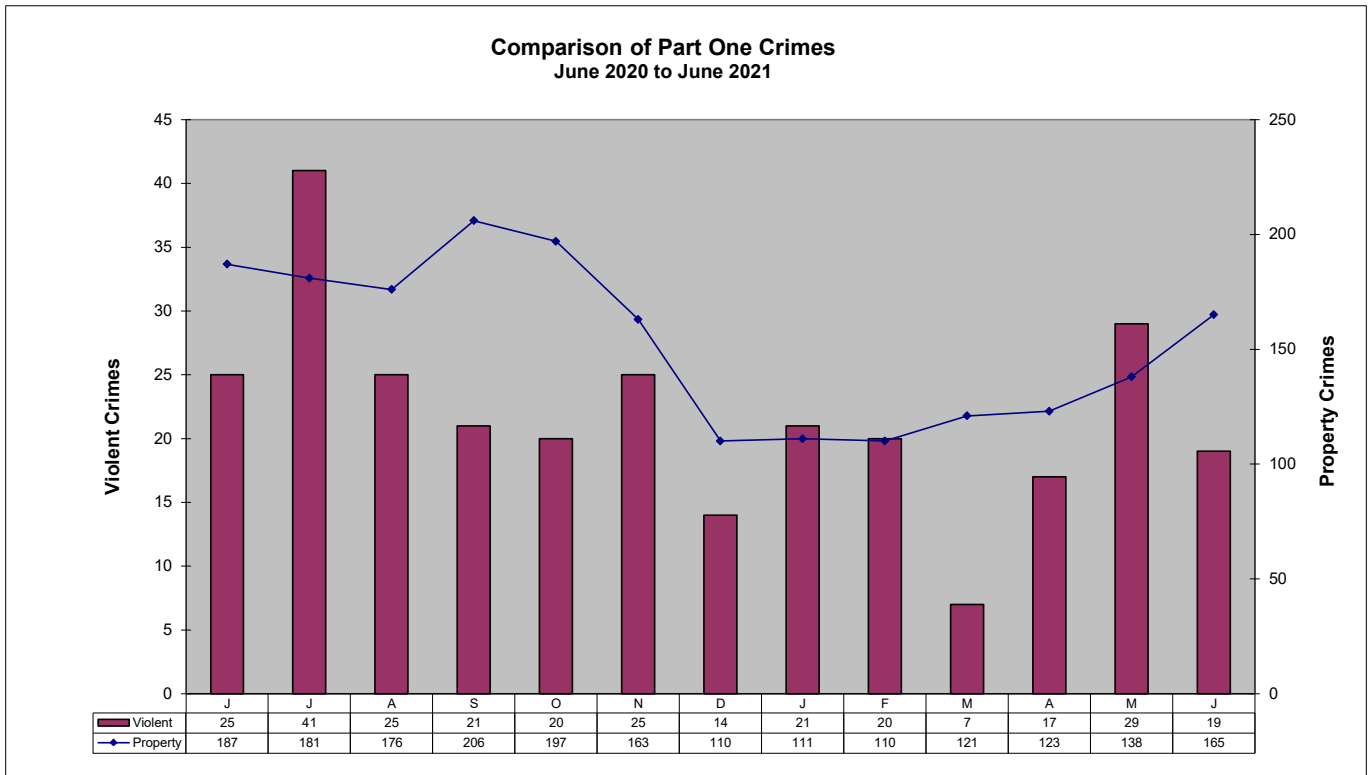

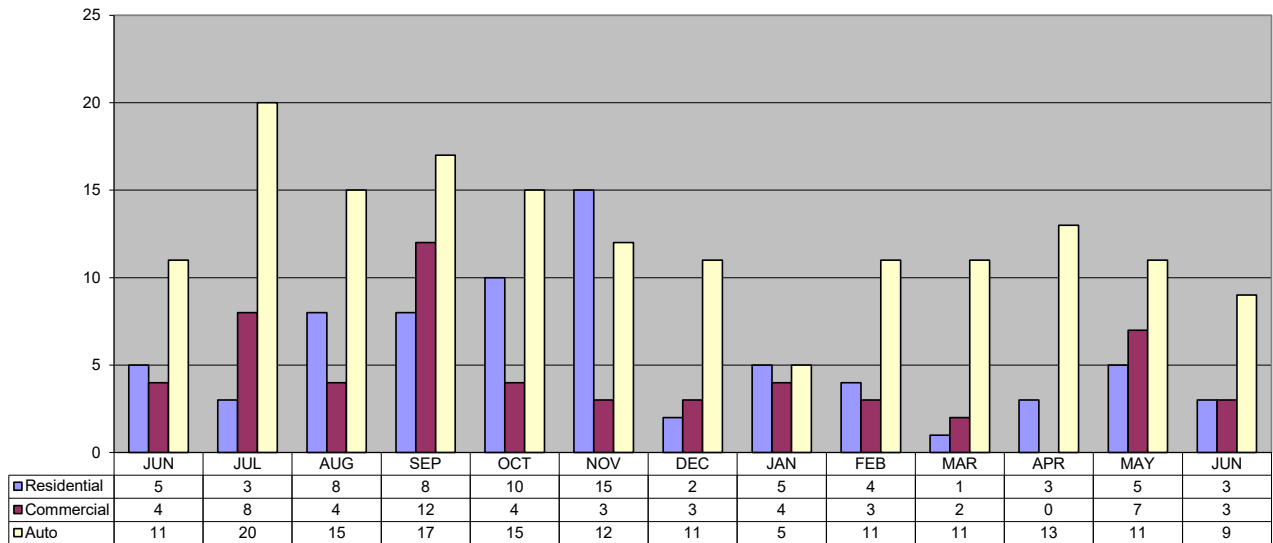

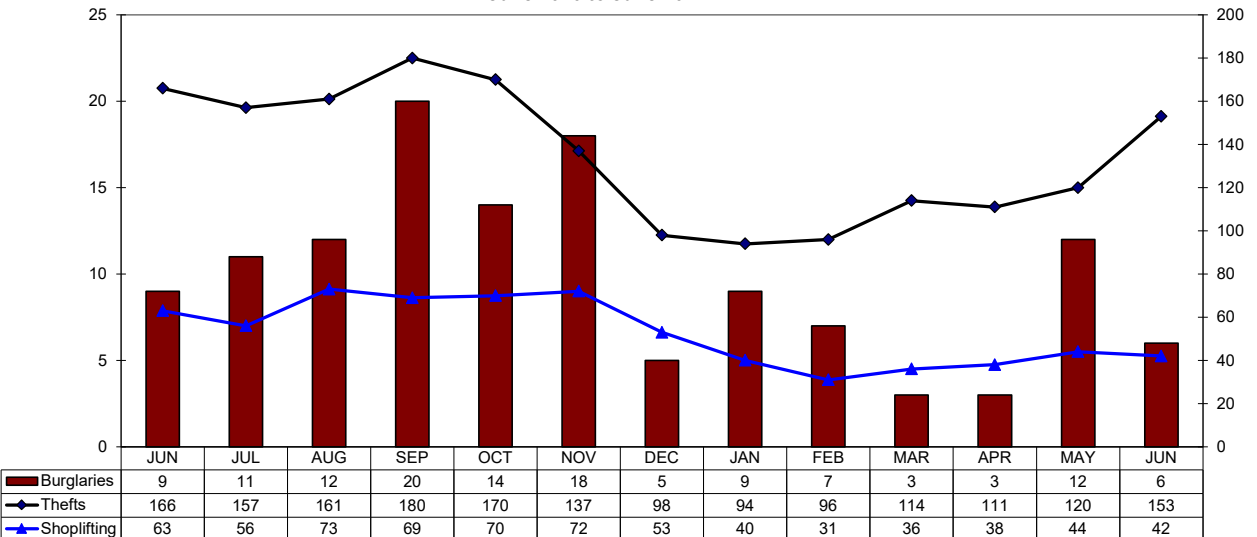

June 2020 to June 2021



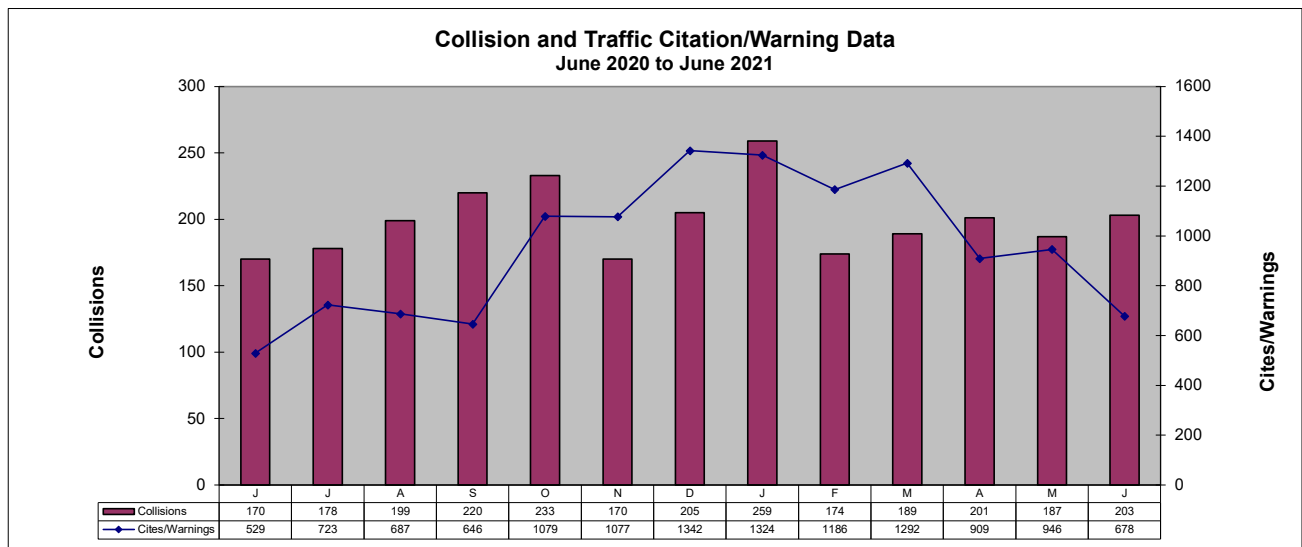
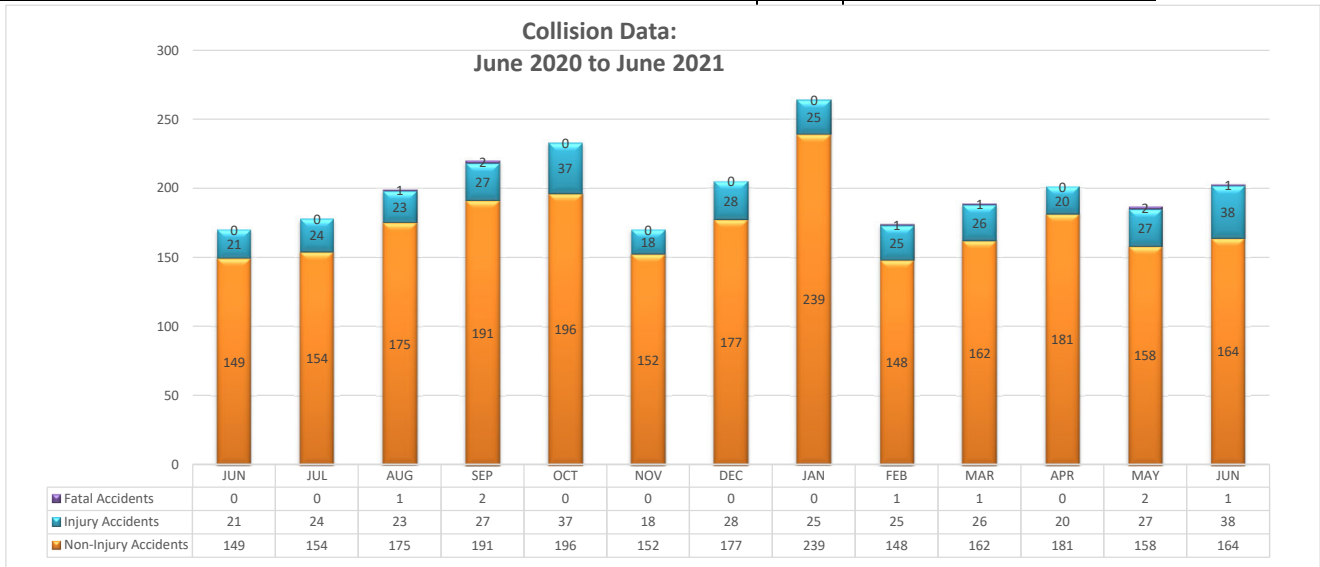
Thirteen Month Comparison of Thefts and Burglaries
June 2020 to June 2021



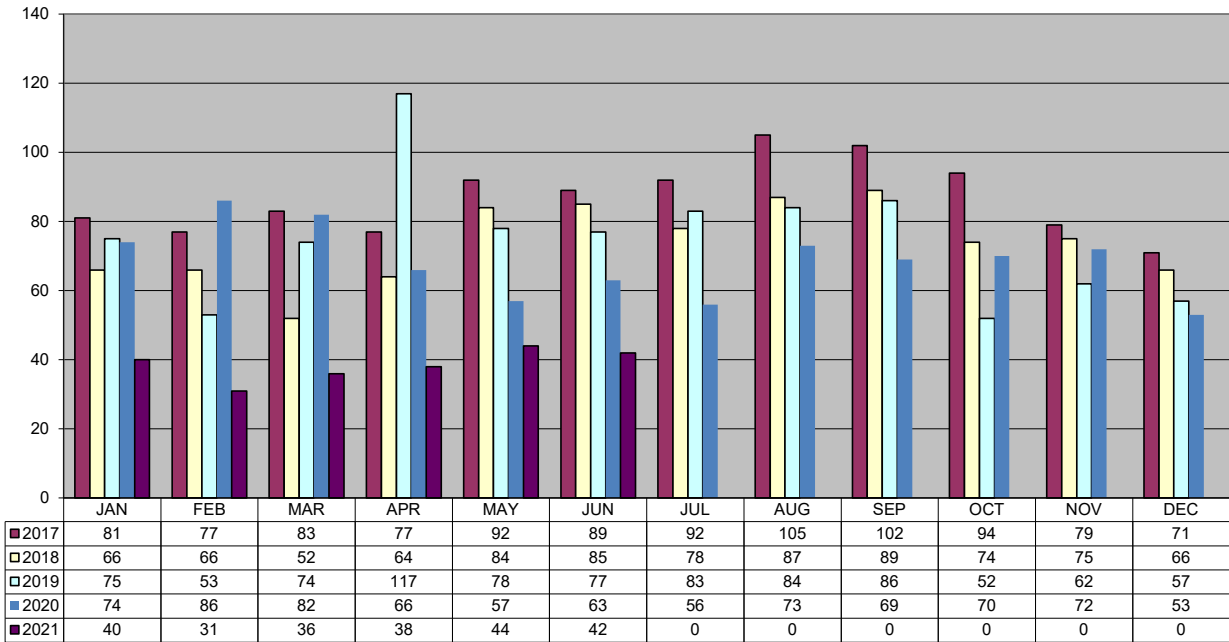

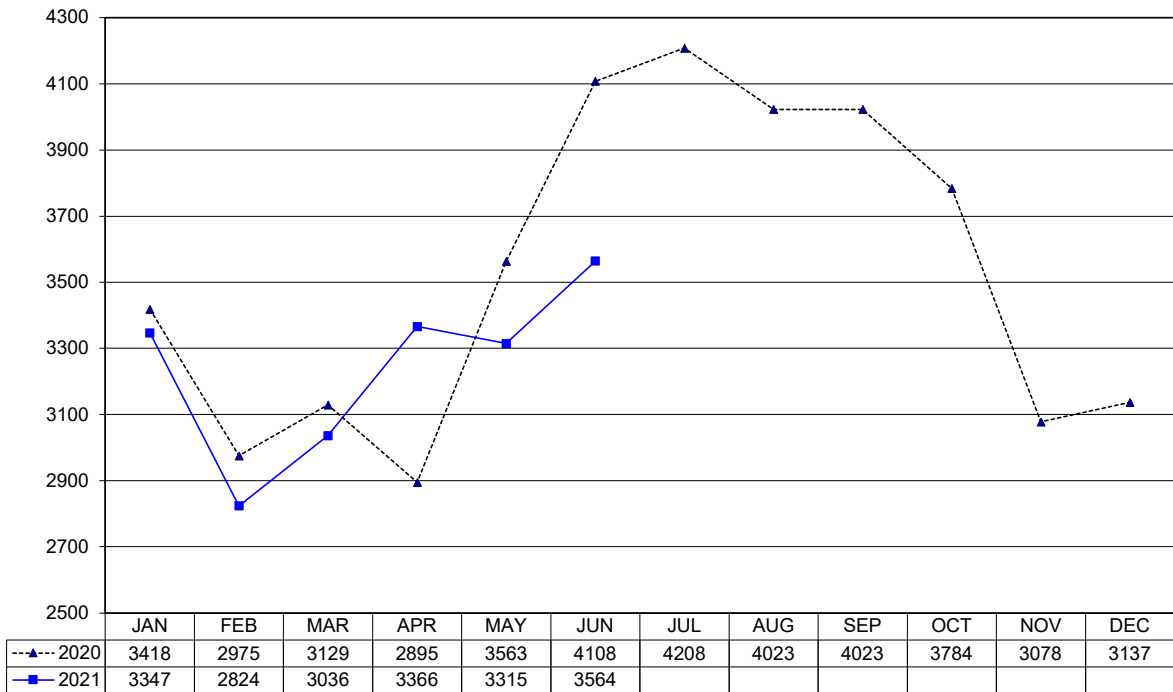

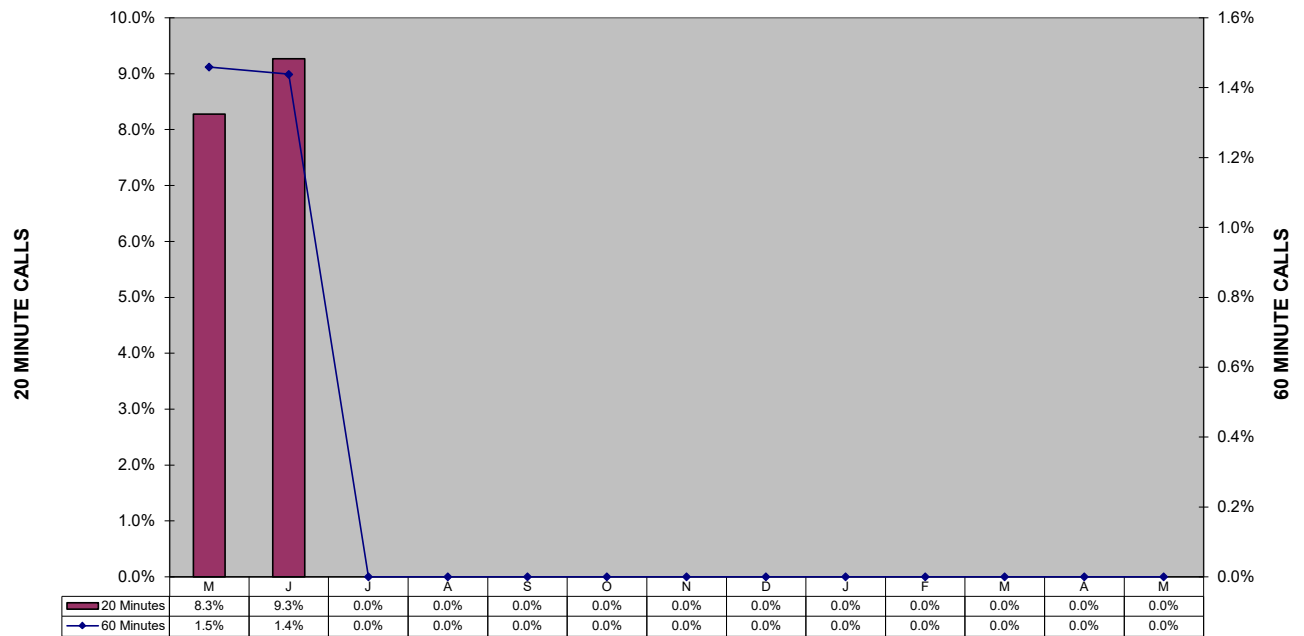
Shoplifting 5-Year Comparison



Police Calls for Service - 12 Month Trend June 2021

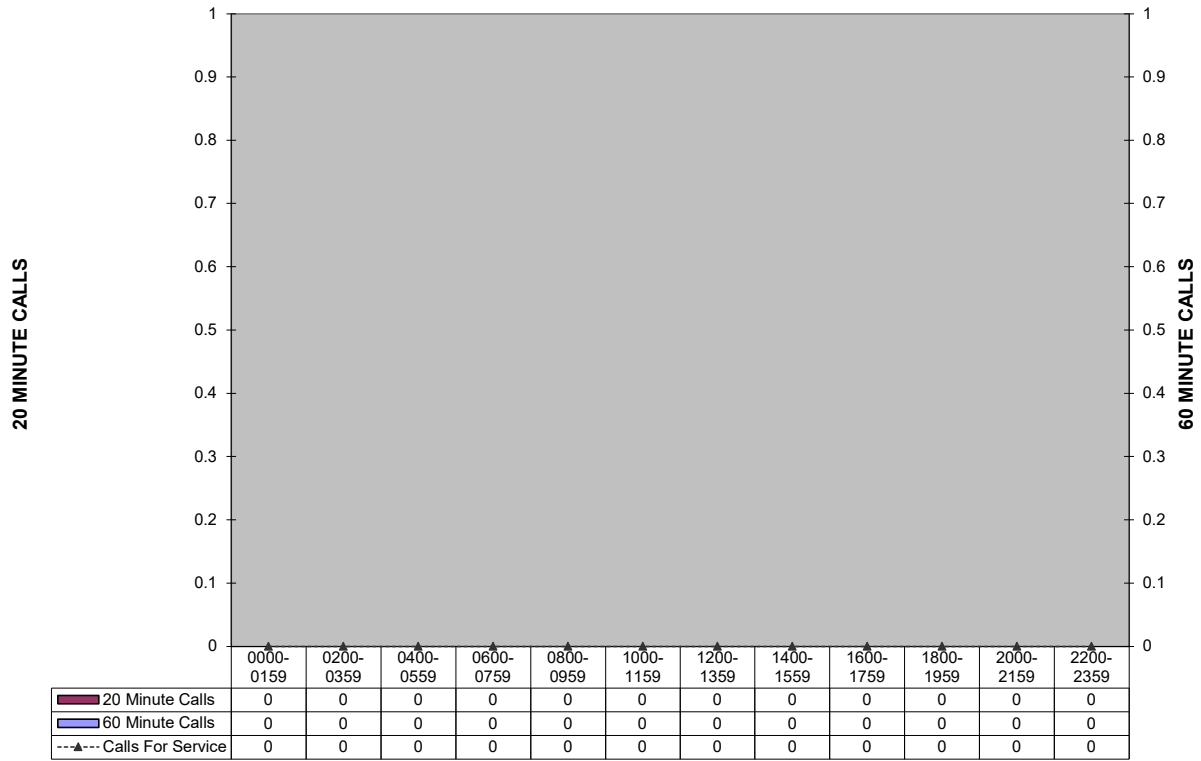


**Percent of Police Calls Held 20 and 60 Minutes
June 2020 to June 2021**

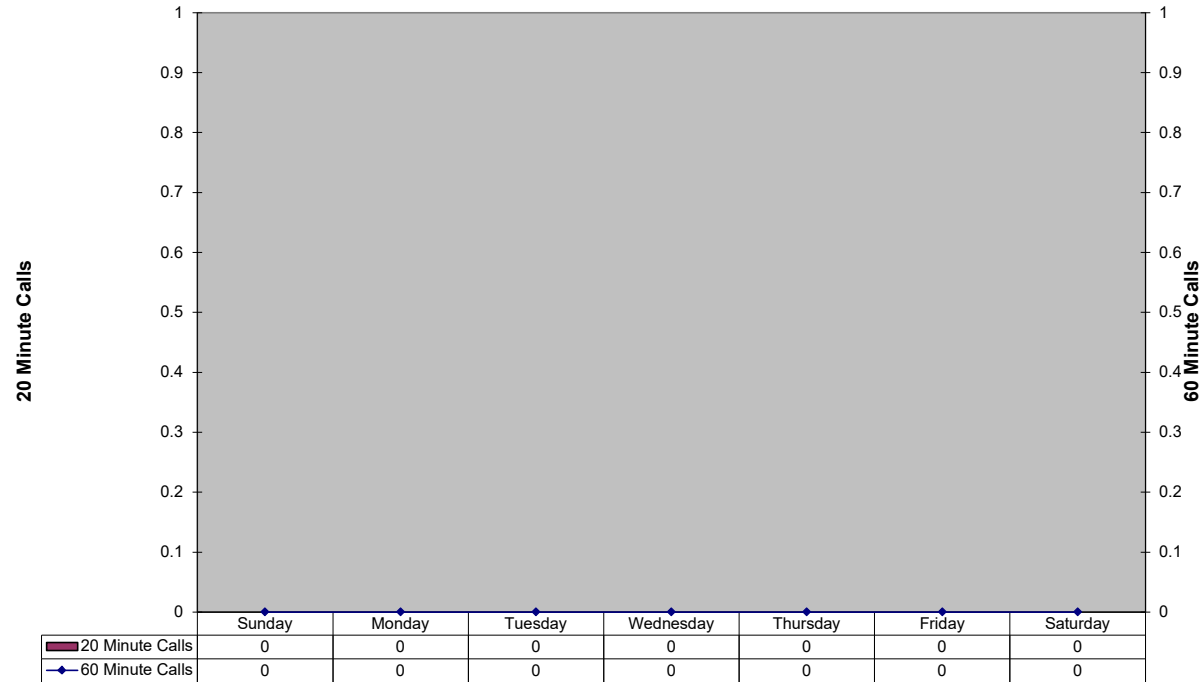

20 and 60 Minute Calls Held by Time of Day (This custom report is being configured)

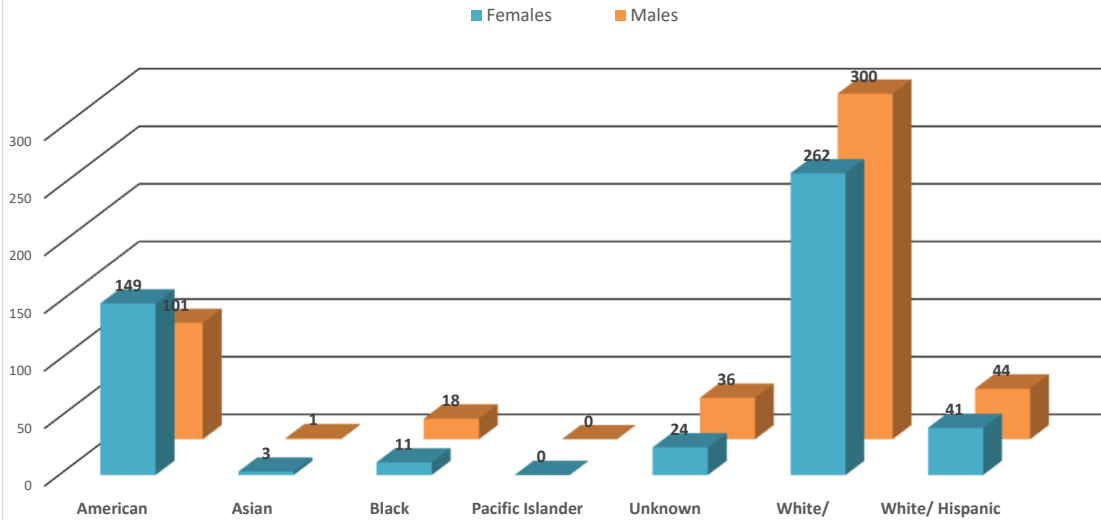


20 and 60 Minute Calls Holding by Day of Week (This custom report is being configured)

June 2021 Year To Date: Felony Incidents- Victims by Race

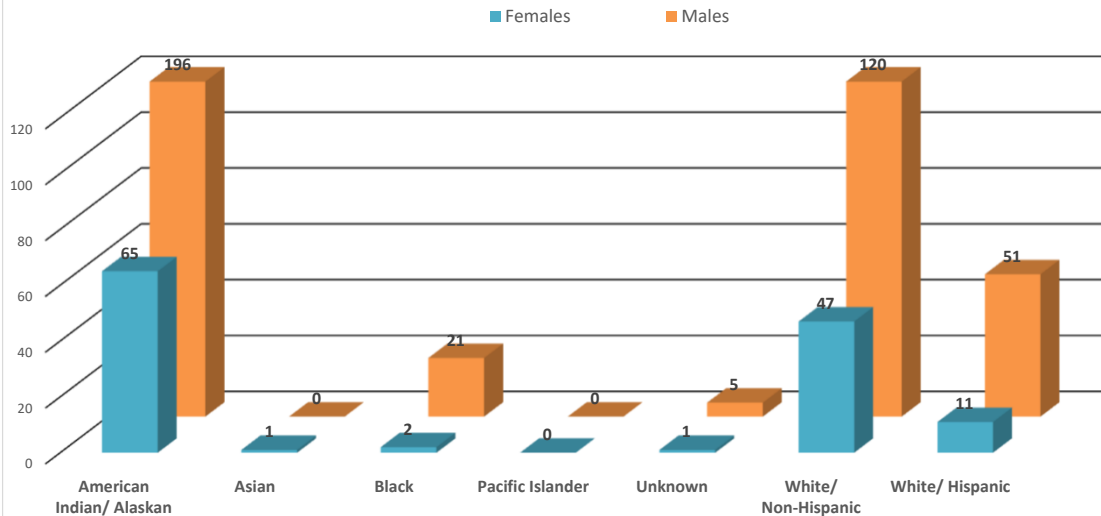

June 2021 Year To Date: Felony Arrests by Race



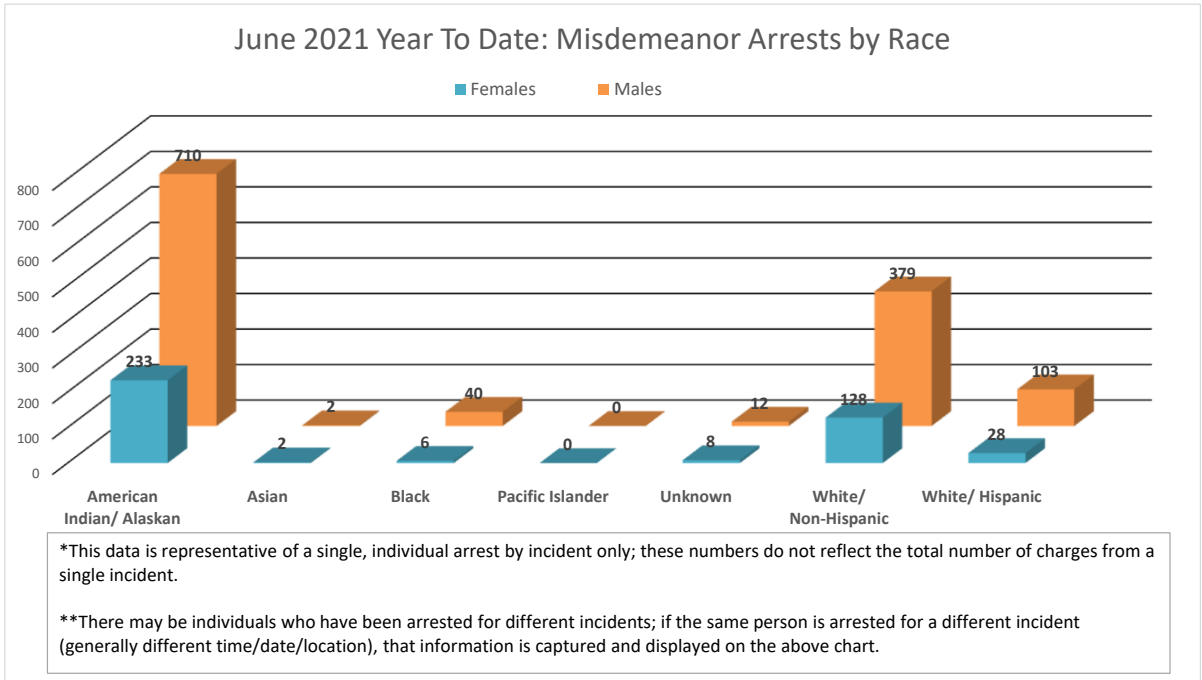
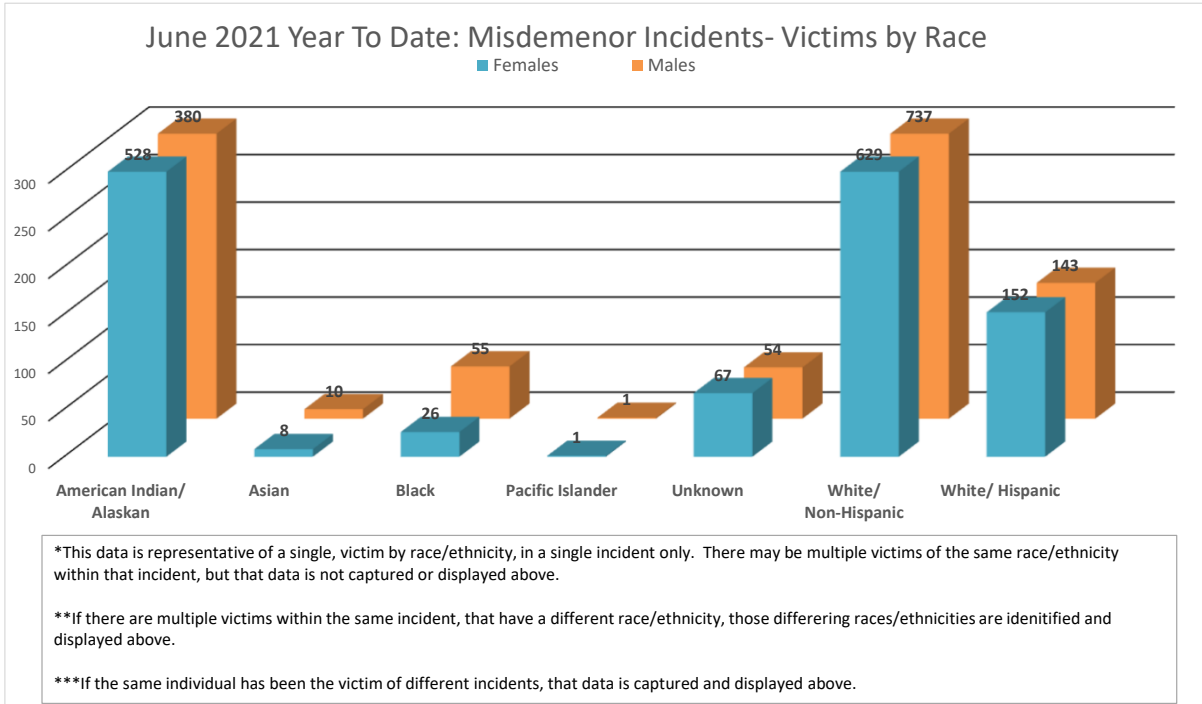
